

Presidential Blog:

With the first month of 2017 coming to a close I wanted to give a brief update where we stand as a community with the changes that have happened for the Town of Advance.

As of January 1, 2017, the Utility staff positions were eliminated. The duties of the electrical system management is being handled by IMPA Service Corp (ISC),

the water/wastewater svstem management is being handled by Utility Management and Construction LLC (UMAC). and the general labor, mowing and snow removal is being handled by Hopper Excavating LLC. All three companies have done a tremendous job so far providing the proper services to our community. In addition, providing those services Nathan Reed was hired by UMAC and Chris Shelton was hired by ISC. Both Nate and Chris did an excellent job for the community and I am very happy that while they are not employed by the Town they are still providing services here.

Dog & Cat Ordinance:

At the last town meeting, an ordinance was adopted that requires all dogs and cats to be registered by December 31st 2016. There is a fee of \$5 per pet or \$15 per residence. Each pet receives a tag for their collar.



If a registered pet gets out, when/if caught, instead of turning him/her over to the Humane Society, town records can be checked to help get your fur baby home. If an unregistered pet is picked up, he/she will be taken to the Humane Society, and the

owner will then have to pay whatever fee they charge to have them returned.

Any registration obtained from now through the end of the year will be good through the end of 2017.

We have the tags in the office, you are welcome go ahead and start coming in anytime during office hours.

We would like to have a photo of each pet on file to help Ray quickly identify and return them in the event they get out. We can either come to you to take a photo, or you can bring your fur babies to the office to visit, which ever works best for you.
