HEAVY TRASH DAY PICK UP DO'S AND DON'TS

- NO PAINT
- **NO BATTERIES**
- **NO LOOSE BRUSH PILES**
- **NO CEMENT**
- NO HEAVY APPLIANCES SUCH AS WASHING MACHINES, DRY-ERS, REFRIGERATORS, HOT WATER HEATERS NO CARCASES NO LARGE PIECES OF METAL
- ITEMS THAT CAN BE PICKED: MATTRESSES, BROKEN DOWN SAT-ELLITE DISHES, TVs, COMPUTERS AND RECLINERS.
- HEAVY TRASH DAY IS AN ADDITIONAL TRASH DAY DURING THE CALENDAR YEAR. PICK UP WILL RUN FROM 8-10AM, SATURDAY APRIL 25, 2020. ITEMS, SUCH AS BRUSH, NEED TO BE BAGGED. IN ADDITION, ANYTHING THAT HAS A LOT OF LOOSE PIECES NEEDS TO BE BAGGED. THE TRUCKS **WILL NOT** GO DOWN AL-LIES. ALL TRASH NEEDS TO BE CURBSIDE, JUST LIKE A NOR-MAL TRASH PICK-UP DAY. THE TRUCK **WILL NOT** CIRCLE BACK IF YOU FORGET TO PLACE YOUR ITEMS BY THE CURB, AND THEY WILL NOT COME UP TO YOUR DOOR TO GET ITEMS.
