ReachAlert:

We would like to make sure each service address has at least one person signed up for the ReachAlert notification service. You can receive alerts via text, phone call, or email. You can have up to 4 cell phones, 4 landlines, and 4 emails registered to each address.

A large number of you have already signed up, and for that, we thank you! We use this service to assist in keeping our residents up to date on any known issues that may effect them including, but not limited to:

- Scheduled and unscheduled outages
- Road Closures
- Reminders of community events
- Safety issues, boil orders, lifting boil orders

Emergency phone:
